## **TAKE PRIDE IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD**

Jackson residents take pride in their homes, and neighborhoods work together to maintain the very best appearance for the overall beautification of the area. Below are several suggestions for helping to keep your neighborhood clean and litter free.

Garbage cans should never be left at curbside between trash pick-up days.

Garbage cans should be placed at curbside on the evening prior to your scheduled trash day to insure pickup as early as 7:00 a.m.

After pickup, all cans should be immediately returned to a proper place outside of the home.

Cans left on the street between trash pickup days are an eyesore and lower property values for the neighborhood.

Residents who do not comply with the Solid Waste Ordinance as it relates to garbage disposal can be charged from \$90 to \$158 per hour if the city has to remove garbage cans from streets in front of homes. Repeat violators can be taken to Environmental Court where they can be fined up to \$1000 and receive up to six months in jail.
